Bacilli Calmette-Guerin (BCG)	Birth
Hepatitis B	2, 4, 6 months
Diphtheria Pertussis Tetanus (DPT)	18 months
Hib	18 months
MMR	15 months, 6 years
OPV	2, 4, 6, 18 months; 6 years
DT	6 years

Required Vaccination

The only vaccine required by International Health Regulations is yellow fever vaccination for travel to certain countries in sub-Saharan Africa and tropical South America

Meningococcal Vaccination is required by the government of Saudi Arabia for annual travel during hajj and Umra

Some Polio Free countries may also require travelers from Polio endemic countries to be immunized against polio in order to obtain an entry visa eg: Saudi Arabia
